Annual Report – 2009

The charge of the Faculty Committee on Enrollment Management is to advise the Regional Chancellor of Academic Affairs and report to the Faculty Senate on matters pertaining to the establishment and maintenance of policies, principles, and regulations affecting student recruitment, admissions/records, and retention.

Dean Frank Hohengarten informed the committee that First-time-in-college (FTIC) applications and enrollment has grown significantly since 2007, primarily from recruiting outside the Tampa Bay area, especially the Jacksonville, Miami, Orlando, and Naples areas. New student numbers from Pinellas County have held steady. There are currently four traveling recruiters who canvas these areas, however budget shortfalls indicate that only two may be available in the future. In addition, USFSP enrolled approximately 120 FTIC students who were waitlisted in Tampa.

Like many other institutions, USFSP purchases list of names of students who take the SAT. These students are contacted via Hobson's email and a few recruitment postcards.

The Transfer student applications and enrollment is decreasing. This might be a result of more Community Colleges offering four year degrees. The recruiters are also not able to easily reach students at SPC now that SPC is offering more 4 year degrees. SPC is not as welcoming as they once were.

A summary of 2007 – 2009 data on application admittance and enrollment is attached.

There has been some restructuring of Enrollment Services this year. Records and Academic Advising now report to Academic Affairs. There is an ongoing search for a University Registrar. Admissions and Financial Aid now report to Student Affairs.
