## Minutes of January 25, 1951

Meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mrs. Bartlett, with the following members present: Mrs. Bartlett, Mrs. Meador, Mr. Christian, Judge Marshall. Dr. Williams, Director of the Juvenile Welfare Board, was also present.

Minutes of the meeting of January 11th, 1951 as mailed to the membership were approved.

Upon motion of Mr. Christian, seconded by Judge Marshall and carried the expenditures from the General Fund as reflected in checks #1941 to 1961 inclusive and from In School Counseling Fund as reflected in checks #126 to 132 inclusive were approved.

Financial report of the Child Guidance Clinic for the period from January 1, 1950 to September 30, 1950 was presented, considered, and ordered filed.

The December activities reports of related child welfare agencies together with brief outlines of intake information of several juvenile court cases and of two Children's Service Bureau cases and the results of their supervision were read and considered.

Mrs. Bartlett reported on the progress being made in appointing advisory committees. She also reported on the progress being made in planning with Judge Bogue, Chairman of the legislative committee.

It was moved by Mr. Christian, seconded by Judge Marshall and carried that the Children's Service Bureau be requested to amend its charter so that it may qualify as an adopting agency for both white and colored children.

The next meeting of the Board was set for February 8, 1951 at 9:30 a.m. in St. Petersburg.

It was **also** agreed that a meeting be held on February 22, 1951 in Clearwater at which time we would meet as a County Children's Commission and as a Juvenile Welfare Board at 9:30 a.m.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting was adjourned.
