Dr. Diamond called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

Following opening remarks by Dr. Diamond and Mr. Mills, the following individuals spoke on behalf of Florida Gulf Coast Autism Association and their interest in maintaining funding for this program: Marie Brown, 10519 98 Street North, Largo; Theresa Halloran, 1304 Withlacoochee Street, Safety Harbor; Rev. Jerome Brown; and Ms. Anne DiNapoli, 1484 52 Avenue NE, St. Petersburg. Harry Neilands, 3700 42 Avenue South, St. Petersburg expressed his concern over the increase of taxes to the Board.

Mr. Mills also distributed a folder of 11 letters received from parents who supported the efforts of the Florida Gulf Coast Autism Association and the funding provided by JWB.

Millage Rate

Mr. Felton moved and Mr. Moriarty seconded a motion which carried unanimously to adopt the following resolution:

Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, in order to provide, to or in behalf of children, services which the Board has determined are needed for the general welfare of the County, finally adopts a millage rate of .5592, which is a 19.9% increase in property taxes.

Mr. Moriarty moved and Mr. Felton seconded a motion which carried unanimously to adopt the following resolution:

Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, in order to provide, to or in behalf of children, services which the Board has determined are needed for the general welfare of the County, finally adopts a budget of \$18,942,632.
