Dr. Diamond presided over the meeting in the Chair's absence and called the meeting to order at 5:55 p.m. Mr. Mills expressed regrets on behalf of Mrs. Welch over her absence at the TRIM and YSAC meetings.

The Board called for public comment and hearing none proceeded with the following motions:

MOTION Dr. Harris moved and Mr. Moriarty and Mrs. Allen seconded a
Approval motion which carried unanimously to adopt the following
Millage resolution:
Rate Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas,
in order to provide, to or in behalf of children, services which
the Board has determined are needed for the general welfare
of the County, finally adopts a millage rate of .4362, which
is a 4.06% increase in property taxes.

MOTION Mrs. Allen moved and Dr. Rose seconded a motion which carried
Adopt unanimously to adopt the following resolution:

Budget Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas
County, in order to provide, to or in behalf of children,
services which the Board has determined are needed for the general
welfare of the County, finally adopts a budget of \$15,735,109.

Adjourn unanimously to adjourn the TRIM hearing at 6:03 p.m.
