Funded Agency Compliance Issues – Quarterly Report

This report keeps the Board advised of compliance matters related to funded agencies.

Staff has removed the following two programs from the compliance report:

- Area Agency On Aging-Fitness is Ageless: After technical assistance by the contract manager, the program has reestablished its intergenerational focus, has just completed a very successful summer program in partnership with the City of St Petersburg, and is expected to meet its FY 00-01 measurable objectives and minimum service levels.
- Family Service Centers-Time Out Homes: The previous program design issue no longer applies. At the June 2001 regular meeting, the Board approved the termination of the Time Out Homes program and transferred \$ 20,000 of that allocation to the Family Service Centers-Father Services Program.
